In 1999, Jor-El became Executive Director of Life Choices in Longmont, Colorado.

A LETTER FROM JOR-EL

Championing Life Amidst Adversity

2023 was our first full year after the sea change brought on by the overturning of *Roe v. Wade*. Along with the welcome protections by pro-life legislators came the angry outburst of abortion proponents to codify abortion practice and promotion. Some states even moved to take away previously popular common-sense funding to help women choose something other than abortion (Pennsylvania, Michigan, Minnesota).

Heartbeat International was directly targeted by the pro-abortion California Attorney General with a lawsuit aimed at Abortion Pill Reversal and our work helping women with their last chance to choose life. We remember well a previous California Attorney General insisting life-loving pregnancy help providers promote abortion in their own facilities and advertising. It took the Supreme Court of the United States to finally reject their efforts with NIFLA v. Becerra. It may take something similar as we stand for life and for those women who regret an abortion they've just begun and want to change their mind.

A quote attributed to Ghandi that I've taken to heart is, "First they ignore you. Then they laugh at you. Then they fight you. Then you win." Well, they ignored us for quite some time. Until we became too effective. Then they laughed, mocked really, our quaint (though biblical) notions of human dignity and the value of the unborn life and the intrinsic power of women. And now they are fighting us tooth and nail and using their elected positions and the taxpayer pockets to do so. We know what comes next.

We feel every bit of 2 Corinthians 8, "We are pressed on every side by troubles, but we are not crushed. We are perplexed, but not driven to despair." That's because **pregnancy help is as important now as ever!** And we are the ones that God has raised up for this very purpose. Abraham Lincoln said, "my greatest concern is to be on God's side, for God is always right."

As the Giver of Life we can't be in a stronger position championing the Gift of Life.

Heartbeat has over 3,500 affiliated pregnancy help locations including pregnancy help medical clinics (with ultrasound), resource centers, maternity homes, and adoption agencies in more than 90 countries worldwide to provide alternatives to abortion.

ABORTION TRENDS

The Changing Face of Abortion Today: Key Findings Unveiled

In the wake of the *Dobbs* decision overturning *Roe v. Wade*, the landscape of abortion has undergone a profound transformation, as detailed in a recent White Paper by Heartbeat International. Here are the key takeaways:

AVAILABILITY

- » Chemical abortion is now easily accessible, with drugs delivered to doorsteps across America and beyond.
- » Telehealth services and numerous websites provide convenient access to abortion drugs, circumventing legal and medical barriers.
- *A tenfold increase has been observed in women obtaining abortion pills online or from acquaintances in the last three years.

COERCION, VIOLENCE, AND POISIONING

- *Shockingly, one in four abortions is unwanted or coerced, with abusers exploiting the availability of abortion pills to control women's reproductive choices.
- Instances of coercion include forced ingestion of abortion drugs, poisoning, and deceptive substitution of medication.

ABORTION BEYOND FDA APPROVAL

- *Chemical abortion, accounting for over 80% of all abortions in the U.S., is increasingly prevalent despite FDA approval limited to the first ten weeks of pregnancy.
- » Overseas protocols, such as those in the UK, extend the use of abortion pills even into the second trimester, posing greater risks to women's health.

REDUCED ASSESSMENT PRIOR TO ABORTION

- » Pre-abortion examinations, crucial for assessing viability, dating, and pregnancy placement, have dwindled, exposing women to greater risks.
- *A concerning decline in ultrasound screenings before abortion initiation has been observed, depriving women of vital information about their pregnancies. Data shows a 38% drop since 2017.

MENTAL AND PHYSICAL EFFECTS FOR WOMEN

- » Chemical abortion, marketed as a safe and private alternative to surgery, poses significant risks, including severe side effects and adverse psychological outcomes.
- » Reported complications include hemorrhage, retained tissue, and even death, underscoring the urgent need for comprehensive medical oversight.


LIVES LOST DUE TO ABORTION

- » In states enforcing total abortion bans, birth rates have risen significantly, indicating a positive impact on the American birth rate.
- » Despite challenges in data reporting, estimates suggest over one million children will be lost to abortion in the U.S. this year alone, with millions more worldwide.



LEGAL ATTACKS

The State of California vs. Heartbeat International

In the ongoing battle for women's reproductive rights, Heartbeat International stands as a beacon of hope and support for those facing difficult decisions. Despite facing legal challenges, our commitment to providing life-affirming options remains unwavering.

California's Attorney General, Rob Bonta, launched an attack against Heartbeat International, aiming to silence our message and disrupt the Abortion Pill Reversal (APR) protocol. This lawsuit, filed in September 2023, alleges false and misleading practices, threatening the vital support we offer to women seeking to reverse their chemical abortions.

Bonta's actions reflect a broader pattern of hostility toward organizations like ours, which provide compassionate alternatives to abortion. Despite claims of deception, the irony lies in the deceptive nature of the accusations leveled against us, as highlighted by the selective use of data and biased sources in the complaint.

The timing of this lawsuit is particularly concerning, given the increasing prevalence of chemical abortions in the United States. It underscores the urgency of ensuring that women have access to accurate information about their options, especially in moments of crisis.

In response to Bonta's legal challenge, we have seen a significant uptick in demand for APR services, reaffirming the importance of our work. APR involves the administration of progesterone, a hormone crucial for sustaining pregnancy, offering a second chance to women who regret their initial decision to undergo a chemical abortion.

Despite the obstacles we face, our resolve remains firm. We refuse to be intimidated or silenced in our mission to provide support and empower women to make informed choices about their pregnancies. The lawsuit not only threatens APR but also jeopardizes the broader pregnancy help movement and the millions of women it serves.

At its core, this legal battle represents an attempt to stifle dissenting voices and withhold critical information from women in need. We reject the notion that advocating for life-affirming options constitutes deceptive or misleading behavior and will vigorously defend our right to provide truthful information and support to those who seek it.



Initially considering abortion as her only option, Cassidy bravely sought help after experiencing regret. Through the Abortion Pill Rescue Network, she was connected with our affiliate, Coastline Women's Center, and received the APR protocol, a groundbreaking treatment that counteracts the effects of the abortion pill. Cassidy was able to save her son's life through APR.

Her son, Dexter, born on May 15, 2023, represents hope and joy amid adversity. Cassidy's gratitude knows no bounds as she reflects on the miracle of Dexter's life and the newfound purpose motherhood has brought her. Sharing her story on social media and at events, Cassidy aims to raise awareness and support for other women facing similar situations.

Supported by organizations like Heartbeat International, which oversees the APRN, Cassidy celebrates each day with Dexter, cherishing the bond they share. Their journey signifies resilience and the transformative power of love and faith. Cassidy acknowledges that Dexter is the greatest gift she could ever receive—a reminder of the blessings that come from embracing second chances and the profound impact of APR in saving lives and restoring hope.

"I thank God for being able to say "yes" to something I had no idea how I would be able to accomplish but knew when I saw that heartbeat on that screen that I would do anything and gain the courage to take the steps to figure it out," said Cassidy.


AN UNEXPECTED OPPORTUNITY AT THE UNITED NATIONS

The tangible impact of these initiatives, facilitated by dedicated volunteers, underscores the transformative power of compassionate care and community support.




CREATING COMMUNITY CHANGE

Heartbeat International's Empower Life Grant, an exclusive operational grant, aims to empower organizations and their communities for lasting change. Eligible candidates, primarily Heartbeat International Affiliates aligned with the Commitment of Care and Competence, including a commitment to sharing the Gospel, are considered for funding. The grant emphasizes representing the organization effectively and includes a comprehensive application checklist. Supported by an anonymous donor, nearly \$3.9 million has been allocated to pregnancy help centers nationwide.

EXPANDING INNOVATION WITHIN THE MOVEMENT

Heartbeat International has pioneered a groundbreaking approach to ultrasound training for nurses and sonographers within the pregnancy help movement, integrating technical, practical, and spiritual elements. This innovative training consists of an online component meeting AWHONN guidelines, followed by in-person sessions featuring one-on-one instruction from experienced educators. The training includes 50+ scanning drills, pregnant models of various gestations, and a unique LOVE Approach Method for imaging preborn babies. With a focus on spiritual guidance and practical application, this comprehensive training equips participants to confidently scan within their centers, reinforcing their calling to serve.







Collaborative Efforts in Supporting Pregnancy Help Organizations

In a landmark collaboration, Heartbeat International has joined forces with Her PLAN, spearheaded by Mississippi Attorney General Lynn Fitch, and several state Attorneys General in a multi-state initiative to celebrate the first anniversary of the *Roe v. Wade* overturn. This monumental effort aims to provide crucial support to over 60 pregnancy centers across the United States.

The initiative, catalyzed by the *Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization* ruling, signifies a pivotal moment in the pro-life movement, heralding the end of 50 years of abortion on demand in the U.S. Under the leadership of Attorney General Fitch, **this endeavor exemplifies a commitment to empowering women and families through tangible action and support.**

This partnership allowed for a streamlined process to ensure that essential supplies reach those in need, empowering pregnancy centers to continue their invaluable work in communities across the nation. It also acted as a model for additional partnerships across the pro-life movement with Heartbeat joining both the March for Life and EveryLife in equipping pregnancy help organizations with the products their clients seek most, highlighting the ongoing relationships that exist between families and centers throughout the pregnancy help movement.

Families who have received a prenatal diagnosis experience a different sort of crisis pregnancy, in that they often are presented with abortion as the only option for a pregnancy that is wanted. Because abortion has become a justifiable treatment option for a prenatal diagnosis, most of these babies — 80% — are aborted. When presented with a comprehensive program of support, more than 80% of parents with a prenatal diagnosis choose to carry to term. Knowing this, in 2023 Heartbeat International, Be Not Afraid, Charlotte Lozier Institute, and Her PLAN launched the Prenatal Diagnosis Initiative (PrenatalDiagnosis.org) to leverage the power of pregnancy help and provide a comprehensive network of support to families facing an adverse prenatal diagnosis.

Through these actions, Heartbeat reinforces its commitment to collaborative efforts that foster positive change and empower communities nationwide. With more than 3,500 affiliated pregnancy help locations around the globe, these organizations play a vital role in offering compassionate care and practical assistance to women and children, as evidenced by their service to almost two million individuals in 2022, with a total service value at more than \$350 millionⁱ.

Heartbeat International continued our collaboration with the Charlotte Lozier Institute and other national affiliation organizations to produce, "Hope for a New Generation," a report on national survey data for pregnancy help.

Key findings from the "Hope for a New Generation" report highlight the impactful services provided by pregnancy centers, including **over 16 million clients sessions in 2022, with 97% reporting positive experiences.** Additionally, these centers served nearly 975,000 new clients, offering vital services such as pregnancy tests, ultrasounds, parenting education, and essential baby supplies.

Support for pregnancy centers remains strong, with 91% of Americans expressing their backing, as per a 2023 Knights of Columbus-Marist Poll.

Heartbeat International continues to champion partnerships that drive meaningful impact and support for those in need. We truly are better together and through these actions, we show that we are united for life!

Option Line® is a pregnancy help contact center, available 24/7 for anyone reaching out for help. Conveniently accessible, Option Line offers compassionate, personalized guidance for all who reach out. Our empathetic confidents provide guidance on their true options, as well as hope for a new shared future for woman and baby. Since answering the first call in 2003, we've reached more than 5 million women and men, many who are desperate for answers in an unexpected pregnancy.

In 2023, we tackled the formidable challenge of marketing pro-life pregnancy help amidst the pervasive promotion of abortion as a quick-fix solution in today's media landscape. Recognizing the urgency of providing women facing unexpected pregnancies with time and support, we launched a groundbreaking Option Line campaign aimed at countering the monopolistic influence of Big Abortion.

Our initiative specifically targeted Gen Y & Z audiences through tailored TV and Media campaigns, strategically designed to meet women where they are and guide them towards life-affirming choices. Through meticulously crafted commercials featuring diverse personas, we endeavored to empower women with the knowledge that they have options beyond abortion and to direct them to local pregnancy help organizations for compassionate support and resources.

In our pilot phase, commercials aired in select cities—Dallas, Chicago, and Atlanta—yielded millions of views resulting in increased connections to pregnancy help.. As we analyze data and adapt our strategies accordingly, we are committed to extending our campaign to new markets and mediums, with the ultimate aim of connecting more women to pregnancy centers nationwide. By expanding into new territories and combating the pervasive narrative of abortion propagated by Big Media, we can collectively make a profound difference in the lives of countless women and unborn children.







Sources of Income*


October 1, 2022 - September 30, 2023
